



# eduroam CONNECTION INSTRUCTIONS

## MACOS 10.4 (TIGER)


- Firstly connect to the 'eduroam\_setup' wifi network and open your web browser




- Click Start to accept the IT Rules and Regulations and continue the setup. If prompted allow Xpress Connect to run the Java application.




- Tell your web browser to trust the Cloudpath Networks certificate




- The setup wizard will now load. Click Continue to configure your device




- In the pop up box make sure that eduroam is listed in the configuration (not eduroam\_temp as shown in the screenshot below). Enter your student or staff ID in the username box followed by @cardiffmet.ac.uk (e.g. [st12345678@cardiffmet.ac.uk](mailto:st12345678@cardiffmet.ac.uk) or [sm12345@cardiffmet.ac.uk](mailto:sm12345@cardiffmet.ac.uk)). Enter your network password in the password box and click Connect




- In the certificate verification box, click Show Certificate




- Place a tick in 'Always trust these certificates' and click Continue



- Click Save to save the new profile



- You will now be successfully connected



- You should now check to make sure that your device has forgotten the eduroam\_setup network as you no longer need it.
